

Privacy statement

1 Online registration relating to the Conference on European Statistics Stakeholders (CESS) 2020

This web page offers you an online electronic registration for the above-mentioned conference. The initiator of the conference is Eurostat and therefore also primarily responsible for the practical arrangements. The President of the Czech Statistical Society is part of the organizing committee of the CESS 2020. In cooperation with the Czech Statistical Society, they offer online registration. The registration system is provided by the Czech Statistical Society. While registering your personal data will be collected and further forwarded to the Chair of the Local Organizing Committee (LOC). The chair will use your personal data exclusively for the purpose of organizing the CESS 2020. As the initiator of the conference, the same applies to Eurostat regarding the processing of your personal data.

In case you wish to verify which personal data is stored on your behalf by the responsible controller, have it modified, corrected, or deleted, or if you have questions concerning any information processed in the context of the conference, or on your rights, feel free to contact the support team, using the above contact information.

3 What personal information do we collect, for what purpose?

The purpose of the processing of personal data collected in the context of the conference is the organization of the conference, including management of contact and participant lists, invitations, conference follow-up, reports, news, publications. The personal data collected and further processed are:

- gender (needed for the right title)/name/surname/profession/postal & e-mail addresses;
- more detailed information regarding the attendance of the CESS 2020.

4 Lawfulness of processing personal data

The processing operations on personal data linked to the organization of this conference are necessary for the management. With your agreement to the privacy statement you have given consent to the processing of your personal data according to Art. 6 Para. 1 a GDPR.

5 The rights of users and data subjects

With regard to the data processing to be described in more detail below, users and data subjects have the right

- to confirmation of whether data concerning them is being processed, information about the data being processed, further information about the nature of the data processing, and copies of the data (cf. also Art. 15 GDPR);
- to correct or complete incorrect or incomplete data (cf. also Art. 16 GDPR);
- to the immediate deletion of data concerning them (cf. also Art. 17 GDPR), or, alternatively, if further processing is necessary as stipulated in Art. 17 Para. 3 GDPR, to restrict said processing per Art. 18 GDPR;

- to receive copies of the data concerning them and/or provided by them and to have the same transmitted to other providers/controllers (cf. also Art. 20 GDPR);
- to file complaints with the supervisory authority if they believe that data concerning them is being processed by the controller in breach of data protection provisions (see also Art. 77 GDPR). In addition, the controller is obliged to inform all recipients to whom it discloses data of any such corrections, deletions, or restrictions placed on processing the same per Art. 16, 17 Para. 1, 18 GDPR. However, this obligation does not apply if such notification is impossible or involves a disproportionate effort. Nevertheless, users have a right to information about these recipients.

6 Who has access to your information and to whom is it disclosed?

Access to the other personal data as well as all information collected in the context of this conference, and the organization thereof, is only granted through UserID/Password to a defined population of users, without prejudice to a possible transmission to the bodies in charge of a monitoring or inspection task in accordance with Union legislation. The users of your data are Eurostat and the Chair of the LOC including their secretariats as responsible organizers for practical arrangements. The Czech Statistical Society provides the registration system and receives your personal data, while not using your data for any other purpose except for forwarding your personal data to the Chair of the LOC.

Some of your personal data (name, organization) may be published on the web in the context of the CESS 2020. If you do not agree with this publication of your personal data, please fill in the registration form accordingly or inform the data controller by using the contact information above and explicitly specifying your request.

In order to keep the network of the participants operational, a contact list of participants may be distributed to attendees which did not deny their assent to do so.

No personal data is transmitted to parties, which are outside the recipients and the legal framework mentioned.

7 What about cookies?

To make this site functions properly, we sometimes place small data files on your computer, known as cookies. Most big websites or internet service providers do this too. Cookies help the site remember your settings language, font size and other preferences for how you want to view the site on your computer so you dont have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to us.

Our cookies are not used to identify you personally. They just make the site work better for you.

You can delete all the cookies already on your computer and you can set most browsers to block them being placed. However, if you do this, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit the site.

The Czech Statistical Society does not use cookies for any other purposes than those presented here and does not use them to collect any personal data for any other purpose.

8 How can you verify, modify or delete your information?

In case you want to verify which personal data is stored on your behalf by the responsible controller, have it modified respectively corrected or deleted, please contact the Controller by using the contact information above and by explicitly specifying your request.

Special attention is drawn to the consequences of a request for deletion, in which case any trace to be able to contact you will be lost.

9 How long do we keep your data?

Your personal data will be part of a list of contact details shared internally amongst the staff of the organizers for the purpose of contacting you in the future in the context of the organizers activities. If you do not agree with this, please use the contact information above and explicitly specify your request.

10 Right of cancellation

You may revoke your prior consent to the processing of your personal data at any time under Art. 7 Para. 3 GDPR with future effect. All you have to do is inform us that you are revoking your consent.

The data previously collected will then be deleted as soon as processing is no longer necessary. However, we must observe any retention periods required under tax and commercial law.
